- A ballot vote will be taken, by the girls of the Assembly, to determine the choice of dress code as outlined below.
- The majority vote rules, and the dress code will be adhered to by all girls and adults attending the regular meetings.
- They can vote to wear formals each meeting, be casual, or be casual one meeting a month and formal the other meeting.
- This vote can be taken each term or each year, again the frequency of the vote is determined by the girls.

GENERAL APPEARANCE

- Proper undergarments must always be worn and not be visible.
- Body piercing jewels (other than one (1) pair of **SMALL STUD** earrings, worn in the earlobes) should not be worn at Rainbow functions.
- No visible tattoos.
- Clothes should be clean and neat in appearance.
- Always "DRESS FOR SUCCESS" keeping in mind that the attire should be AGE and EVENT appropriate.
- Be sure shirts are long enough that there are no bare midriffs when arms are raised.

*** If nylons are not used, "peds" or "toe socks/foot covers" of some kind are required.**
