Our California Rainbow For Girls Foundation (CRFGF) continues to support our girls in countless ways such as Leadership training, Camp Harmony and Scholarships. Unfortunately our ending membership balance for 2010 has continued to decline. We had 2 assemblies close due to lack of adult advisors and mentors. Please help by recruiting the young ladies you know or come into contact with to help reverse this trend. The program we offer in life skills, time management, self esteem and ethics is priceless and must be passed on to the next generation. In order to hold Grand Assembly in an **Arena**, we need **absolutely everyone to go through our Grand Assembly housing**. The 12% room tax occupants pay comes right back to us to pay for the arena rental. As you know, starting at Grand Assembly 2010, the Grand Executive Committee decided to include Past Grand Officers in the same procedures our assemblies and others registering have been following for the last 6 years. That means your **registration and housing** are on the **same form**. You send the **original completed Registration/Housing form to the Registration Chairperson** and a **copy of the same Registration/Housing form to the Housing Chairperson** to obtain your housing. Registration/Housing forms sent in by February 22 (the Assembly due date) have a better chance of getting into the Radisson. The March 1 due date is strictly to accommodate Past Grand Officers but may not assure housing at the Radisson.
