TO RAINBOW GIRLS, IN GOOD STANDING, AND MAJORITY MEMBERS WHO ARE
INTERESTED IN APPLYING FOR A SCHOLARSHIP

California Rainbow for Girls Foundation, Inc. has a scholarship program designed to provide financial aid to those girls entering, or continuing undergraduate programs in college or trade schools. The criteria for all scholarships include: Rainbow activity, school and community activity and service, scholarship, and financial need. The Florence McDonald Music and the Jessie D. Nelson Scholarships have additional criteria as explained below.

The **Regular Rainbow Scholarship** provides financial aid to those girls planning to enter undergraduate studies as freshman. The \$500 scholarship is paid to the recipient in two installments. The first installment will be paid approximately the middle of August but only after proof of enrollment has been received by Mr. Dennis Conwell, Chairman, Scholarship Committee. The second installment will be paid at the end of the first semester and after a transcript of grades and proof of continuing enrollment have been received by Mr. Conwell.

The **Continuing Student Scholarship** provides financial aid in the amount of a \$500 scholarship to girls continuing studies beyond their freshmen year if there are funds remaining after the **Regular Rainbow Scholarships** have been awarded. **Girls applying for a continuing student scholarship should indicate this when requesting application forms and when submitting their completed scholarship packet.**

The **Florence McDonald Music Scholarship** provides financial aid to a girl planning to study music. The \$500.00 scholarship is paid in two installments, in the same manner as the Regular Rainbow Scholarship.

The **Beverly Sanders Book Scholarship** is available to a Rainbow Girl who is being awarded a Regular Rainbow Scholarship whom the committee believes needs and deserves the additional funds. This scholarship will be in the amount of \$100.00 to \$250.00 depending on the amount available in the Endowment Fund.

The **Jessie D. Nelson Scholarship** is available to a sophomore and higher grade level girl who is continuing studies in the health and medical field. The \$2,500.00 scholarship is paid in two installments, in the same manner as the Regular Rainbow Scholarship.

The **Anna Lind Scholarship** is given annually in the amount of \$1000.00, with the amount subject to the availability of funds in the Endowment Fund.

The **RAINBOW GIRL HERSELF MUST APPLY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION** using one of the following methods:

All forms, in order to be considered, must be filled out COMPLETELY and NEATLY, and sent to Mr. Dennis Conwell by **FEBRUARY 15TH, EVERY YEAR**, - this means application forms **must be postmarked by that date.** APPLY NOW FOR FORMS. The committee will evaluate and select the students to whom the awards shall be given. The names of the girls receiving the scholarship awards will be announced at Grand Assembly. Written verification of the awards will be mailed to the individual girls within two weeks after the close of Grand Assembly.

The Scholarship Committee urges the Mother Advisor, as well as the Chairman of the Advisory Board, to see that this letter is kept on file in the Mother Advisor's binder.

Contributions to the Scholarship Fund may be given as memorials, as well as outright donations or gifts. Checks should be made payable to the **CALIFORNIA RAINBOW FOR GIRLS FOUNDATION, INC. (CRFGF)** and designated for the Scholarship Fund, the McDonald Music Endowment Fund, the Beverly Sanders Scholarship Fund or the Anna Lind Scholarship Fund. AN EDUCATED MAJORITY MEMBER is an even better Majority Member. She may apply for a Regular or Continuing Student Scholarship up to four (4) years after her High School Graduation.
